Monday, Day 1 | To Chicago via Train!

This morning meet your Adventure Guide at Union Station in Saint Paul, just inside the main entrance door. She will assist you in checking your luggage and getting your train ticket. You will then board the Empire Builder train for your journey to Chicago! Sit back and relax in your roomy recliner seat as the countryside passes by. Enjoy lunch on your own on-board the train. Arrive in Chicago in the early evening to board your waiting coach that will take you to dinner at a local icon, the Historic Berghoff Restaurant, for some wonderful German food. You will then check into your Chicagoland Hotel which will be your homebase for the next 4 nights.

Tuesday, Day 2 | Touring Chicago & A River Cruise!

After your included breakfast, enjoy a guided tour with a local guide. You'll experience Chicago's "Loop," Buckingham Fountain, Little Italy and Greektown where you will enjoy an included lunch. You will also explore Millennium Park, a 24.5 acre rooftop garden built over an underground parking garage. You will then board an Architecture Cruise boat for a cruise on the Chicago River. You'll learn about Chicago's historic role as the birthplace of modern American architecture gazing upon more than 40 famous buildings along the scenic route. You will then head back to your hotel to relax for the rest of the evening.

Wednesday, Day 3 | A Whirlwind Day in Chicago!

Following breakfast, depart with your group to visit the world famous 360 Chicago at the top of the former John Hancock Building. 360 Chicago soars 1,000 feet



above Lake Michigan overlooking the city's majestic skyline offering visitors like you the most breathtaking views of downtown Chicago, the lakefront, and the four neighboring states. Add to that their interactive technologies and their 94th floor café, and you have a day to remember! You will then depart 360 Chicago for the Shedd Aquarium and Oceanarium to visit with the fishes in a beautiful Art Deco setting where you will have lunch on your own. After enjoying The Shed Aguarium, depart for an interesting "Untouchable Tour" through the 1920's & 1930's Prohibition Era of Chicago. Visit the hot spots, hit spots, and hideouts made famous by Al Capone. After the tour, your group will be dropped off at Navy Pier to explore all the sights and sounds of this amazing place. Ride the famous ferris wheel, wander the shops, or grab a table outside to enjoy some of Chicagoland's various foods or a local brew! Later on, enjoy fireworks from the pier!

Thursday, Day 4 | Lincoln Park & Teatro ZinZanni!

After breakfast depart for the Lincoln Park Zoo, which operates one of the largest zoo-based conservation and science programs in the country. You can see roaring lions, playful meerkats, and majestic gorillas. View red wolves, peer into a black bear den, and immerse yourself in the sights and sounds of Africa with wild dogs, pygmy hippos, and black rhinos. After visiting the zoo, head just next door to tour the Conservatory. Built between 1890 and 1895, the historic Lincoln Park Conservatory displays lush, exotic plants from around the world in four display houses. After enjoying all the flora and fauna, depart for Chicago's famous Magnificent Mile where you will enjoy some



shopping and touring on your own. The Magnificent Mile is Chicago's version of Paris' Champs-Elysées - a grand wide boulevard with shops, museums, restaurants and ritzy hotels. After some touring, head back to your hotel to get a little dressed up for your farewell evening as you will be heading out to the best theater in Chicago, Teatro ZinZanni! Housed in a treasure of both history and magic: an antique Belgian Spiegeltent. This intricate structure transports us to a bygone era of opulence, blending artistry with entertainment. As you step inside, you're transported into a world where history and contemporary entertainment unite. Lit by chandeliers and bathed in a warm glow, it's the perfect setting for intimate one-of-a-kind performances that include circus arts, live music, comedy and a multi-course feast. It will be a great way to end the day and spend our last evening together. Head back to your hotel to pack up for the trip home.
