You will actually hear some of those first original recordings while standing right in the place where they were recorded. It's cool! You will then head back to the hotel to enjoy dinner at the hotel.

Day 4 | National Civil Rights Museum & Graceland

After your included breakfast, depart your hotel for the National Civil Rights Museum, which is located in the hotel where Dr. Martin Luther King was assassinated. The motel looks just the same as the day this happened, and the accompanying museum attached to the motel is fascinating. After touring the museum depart for Graceland, where you'll find everything "Elvis" that you could possibly want to see. Here is where you will enjoy an "audio guided" tour of Graceland, Elvis' home. At the end of the tour, make a stop at his grave
