The stunning NaPail Coast has served as the backdrop for Hollywood blockbusters, such as Jurassic Park and King Kong. With endless emerald landscapes, Kauai truly lives up to its nickname of "The Garden Island". DAY NINE | MAUI Once the favorite playground of Hawaiian royalty, great warrior King Kamehameha chose to make Maui his capital after uniting the Hawaiian islands.
