Queensland, Australia. The protected sand island is known for its beaches and steep dunes, like Mount Tempest. On the west coast, a dive site features coral and tropical fish around a group of sunken boats called the Tangalooma Wrecks. A dolphin feeding spot is nearby and Humpback whales can be viewed from Cape Moreton, the site of a 19th-century lighthouse. There are many shore excursions to choose from here so enjoy your day the way you see fit!

DAY 7 | A Day At Sea Part 2

Enjoy another day at sea as you sail northward towards the Great Barrier Reef. There is entertainment everywhere, so either join in or relax with a good book by the pool. DAY 8 | Airlie Beach

Go-Go-Go Travelers | Level 3-Difficult: 5-7+ miles walking each day

DAY 10 | Port Douglas

In 1877, the aptly named James Venture Mulligan struck pay dirt on Hodgkinson River, igniting the fabled North Queensland Gold Rush. At the height of the boom, Port Douglas boasted 12,000 residents and 27 hotels. Bust inevitably followed boom, and Port Douglas slid into decades of obscurity. Then came a second gold rush in the 1980s as tourists flocked to the North Queensland Coast. Located between the Wet Tropics World Heritage Area and the Great Barrier Reef, Port Douglas provides a perfect gateway to adventurers en route to rain forest and reef. Here you have the opportunity to see the Great Barrier Reef from a different location or take the skyway cable train through the rain forest.

DAY 11 | Willis Island

This tiny island measures in at just 1,600 feet long by 490 feet wide, though it is the only permanently inhabited island in the Coral Sea Islands Territory. You won't find any neighborhoods, schools or homes here, however. The only structures on Willis Island comprise a weather monitoring station hosted by the Australian Bureau of Meteorology, where just a handful of weather observers reside at any given time. Willis Island is one of several tropical islands sitting beyond the Great Barrier Reef in the Coral Sea Islands Territory, and is surrounded by thriving reefs where many creatures make their homes. Numbering into the thousands, Willis Island itself caters to many species of seabirds, including Masked, Brown and Red-footed Boobies that cry out nearly 24 hours a day. It is also an important nesting ground for turtles. Note: Willis Island is a scenic cruising site. Ships will slowly travel past while a knowledgeable port lecturer points out significant sites you'll be able to see from onboard.

DAY 12 | A Day At Sea Part 3

This will be your last full day of cruising, so make the most of it! Swim in the pool, get a massage, learn how to fold animal towels, play bingo, the list goes on and on. One thing you should not forget to do....and that is to pack this evening for your departure from the ship tomorrow!

DAY 13 | Brisbane

This morning after one last included breakfast, it's time to leave the ship. After disembarking, pick up your luggage and head out the terminal to your waiting coach. Enjoy a full day tour of Brisbane including a stop at the Lone Pine Koala Sanctuary where you will get to hold a koala! You will then check into your hotel for one last evening in Australia. Enjoy dinner on your own at the hotel restaurant and then join your fellow travelers for one last toast to a fantastic trip!

DAY 14 | Flying Home

Depart for the airport where you will board your flight for Los Angeles. 11:20 AM: Your Fiji Airways flight departs



Brisbane for Los Angeles. Enjoy included food and beverage while in flight. There will be a short stopover in Fiji before you continue on to North America.....or will you??!! If you like, you may exit the airport and enjoy three glorious days right on the beach in Fiji! But if you have decided to head towards home, you will board a departing overnight flight and arrive in Los Angeles at 11:50 AM (just 30 minutes after you departed Brisbane! Continue towards home arriving in the early evening with lots of memories of your amazing voyage in Australia, sailing the Coral Sea!
