DAY TWO | TOURING WASHINGTON D.C.

After an included breakfast, depart for a full-day tour of Washington D.C. including the U.S. Capitol, The White House, Washington Monument, Lincoln Memorial, FDR Memorial, Martin Luther King Jr National Memorial & the Korean, WWII & Vietnam War Memorials. Lunch & dinner will be on your own as you enjoy touring around D.C. with the group.

DAY THREE | MT. VERNON & ARLINGTON CEMETERY

This morning, after an included breakfast, head to George Washington's Mount Vernon Estate. You will tour Washington's home, farm & gardens. Walk down the lovely path to Washington's grave site, where our Founding Father and his wife are buried. Then, head back to the entrance for an included lunch on-site at the Mt. Vernon Inn. You will then depart with your group to tour a very sacred place ~ The Arlington National Cemetery. Ride in an open air cart to view the Tomb of the Unknown Soldiers, the changing of the guard, the Kennedy graves, the Robert E. Lee home & the Iwo Jima

Memorial. Head back to your hotel for dinner on your own and one of the many restaurants in the area.

INCLUDED BREAKFAST/LUNCH

DAY FOUR | SMITHSONIAN MUSEUMS & THE NATIONAL CATHEDRAL

Depart this morning for a free day on the National Mall to visit the Smithsonian Museums. Enjoy lunch on your own at one of the many cafeterias in the museums...or maybe buy a hot dog or sandwich from a street vendor! Later on in the afternoon, head up embassy row where many of the world's embassies are based. You will then arrive at The Washington National Cathedral to tour the interior of the church with a special guide. Look for the rock from the moon embedded in one of the stained glass windows! At 5:30 PM enjoy a half hour "Evensong" service with the cathedral choir. Then head back to your hotel to relax and enjoy dinner on your own.

DAY FIVE | BULL RUN BATTLEFIELD AND GETTYSBURG

This morning after an included breakfast, load your luggage on the coach and head to the very first battlefield of the Civil War, Bull Run. Here, the 1st Minnesota Regiment stood their ground as others retreated around them. Captain Lawrence Frederickson of the 1st Minnesota Corp will share his story of what happened that day. Dressed in union uniform, Captain Fredrickson will bring the battle alive. Then, it's time to depart for Gettysburg. Enjoy the drive through the spring countryside with a stop for lunch on your own. You will then arrive in this small village where the most important battle of the Civil War was fought. Enjoy some free time to poke around the cute downtown area before checking into your Gettysburg Hotel for the next two nights. This evening enjoy dinner on your own at a local restaurant.

DAY SIX | GETTYSBURG VISITOR CENTER AND TOUR

After a relaxing breakfast, depart for the Gettysburg Visitor Center to enjoy the museum & an informational



film about the Battle of Gettysburg. You will then head upstairs to view the historic Cyclorama. The Cyclorama was painted in the late 1800's & toured the United States at that time, so that people could experience the Gettysburg battle. It is as long as a football field & brings "Pickett's Charge" to life. After enjoying lunch on your own at the Visitor Center, it's time to head out on a tour of the battlefield with Captain Frederickson as he explains the highlights of the three day Gettysburg Battle. Especially interesting is the story of the 1st Minnesota Regiment & how they saved the war on day two! You will have an opportunity to take the charge with him and defend the union while the battle horn blows! Then return to your hotel for a little R & R before heading to a historic restaurant to enjoy your last evening together with the group!

DAY SEVEN | THE RETURN HOME

Enjoy your included breakfast before packing up to depart for home. Before departing Gettysburg, a stop will be made at the Gettysburg National Cemetery where Lincoln gave his Gettysburg Address.
