You will then continue to the Black Hills and check into your hotel in the country, with spectacular views of Mt. Rushmore. Here you will stay for the next 3 nights. ### Day 3 | Deadwood, Custer State Park & Mount Rushmore

Enjoy some free time to poke around the town and maybe enjoy visiting some of the gaming saloons. Then, drive the wildlife loop at CUSTER STATE PARK. The Loop Road takes you through rolling prairies & pine covered hills, offering one of the best spots in the region to view native animals in the wild. Afterwards head

to the MOUNT RUSHMORE NATIONAL MEMORIAL, America's "Shrine of Democracy" & a symbol of the nation's rich history, rugged determination & love of freedom. We will arrive early enough to explore its beauty during the daylight but then as the sun sets, prepare yourself to be "Wowed" with the spectacular LAZER LIGHT SHOW as darkness settles in and the Black Hills shine!

### Day 4 | Steam Train, Crazy Horse & Dances With Wolves

After another included breakfast, board the 1880's STEAM POWERED TRAIN for a two-hour excursion through the Black Hills. This relaxing, scenic ride transports you between Hill City and Keystone in fully refurbished train cars. This historical steam train experience is narrated with on-board hosts pointing out sights of interest along the way. You will be able to get lunch here and may bring it on the train if you would like. Your next stop will be CRAZY HORSE VISITORS CENTER, just a short distance away. This is home to the 5th granite face of the Black Hills, Lakota leader "Crazy Horse". The visitor's center also houses the beautiful Indian Museum of North America. You will then enjoy a visit to the DANCES WITH WOLVES FILM SET. Walk along the boardwalk and experience the movie set and the Wild West! Dinner this evening will be a...a toe-tapping - hand-clappin' good time at the FT. HAYES CHUCKWAGON & COUNTRY SHOW.
