DAY 2 | LAKE LOUISE

The famous glacier-fed, turquoise waters of Lake Louise are yours to admire this morning at Banff Lake Louise Lodge. Perhaps you will choose to hike along the lakeshore or simply relax in the majesty of your surroundings. Enjoy lunch at the Ski Lake Louise Lodge before boarding a gondola, which ascends the mountain in fourteen minutes to a height of 6,850 feet above sea level. Then head back to your hotel for a relaxing evening on your own.

BREAKFAST/LUNCH DAY 3 | BANFF ICEFIELDS



Set out along the unforgettable Icefields Parkway and behold lofty waterfalls, rushing rivers, glacial peaks, imposing cliffs, and snowcapped mountain ranges. Stop at the Athabasca Glacier where you will ride in a snow coach across this mass of glacial ice nearly 1,000 feet thick, the largest accumulation of ice south of the Arctic Circle! This afternoon, stop at stunning Peyto Lake, a glacier-fed lake that evokes pure serenity. Be on the lookout for bears and stately elk on your return to Banff.

DAY 4 | DRIVING TO WATERTON LAKES

Depart your hotel today for Waterton Lakes. Enjoy the stop in Banff at the powerful Bow Falls and Surprise Corner known for its picture-perfect panoramic views. Relax during your journey and soak in a backdrop of wonderful wildlife and the majestic Canadian Rockies. This afternoon check in to the historic Prince of Wales Hotel for the next two nights.

BREAKFAST/DINNER HOTEL: PRINCE OF WALES

DAY 5 | GLACIER NATONAL PARK

Today, experience Glacier National Park, a naturalist's paradise. Glacier preserves over one million acres of forests, alpine meadows, and lakes, and is home to over 70 species of mammals and 270 species of



birds. Enjoy a ride aboard one of its famous Jammer cars – built in the 1930s – along one of the most breathtaking roads in North America. Going-to-the-Sun Road stretches across the Continental Divide and offers incredible views of the valley and Glacier National Park. An amazing day. This evening head back to your historic hotel to enjoy dinner on your own.

Day 6 | BUFFALO JUMP AND NORTH TO CALGARY

This morning, journey north through prairie lands while enjoying the distant views of the spectacular Rockies. Visit Head-Smashed-In Buffalo Jump, a UNESCO World Heritage site and one of the world's oldest, best preserved buffalo jumps. Head-Smashed-In, in the foothills of the Rockies, has been used continuously by Aboriginal people for over 5,500 years. A Blackfoot guide brings to life the culture of the Plains people, the Buffalo Hunt, and the many secrets uncovered in archaeological digs. Then continue on to Calgary, where you will enjoy a tour of the city. You will then check into your hotel for the evening. Enjoy an included farewell dinner in the attached Italian Restaurant. Then it's off to pack for departure tomorrow and get a good night's sleep!
