DAY ONE | Traveling to South Africa

Meet Dave and Jeanie Johnston, your Adventure Guides at the main MSP Terminal 1 Lindberg in the afternoon. You will then board your overnight flight to Cape Town, South Africa.

DAY TWO | Arriving in Cape Town

DAY THREE | Touring Cape Town

This morning after an included breakfast, a local guide will meet you at your hotel and take you to Table Mountain. Board a cable car that will rotate to give you a full 360 degree view of the City of Cape Town for 3 minutes as you ride to the top. When you arrive at the Upper Cable car station, you will have some free time to walk around on top of the mountain. You can also have a coffee and a snack as a restaurant is located there. After riding back down, your bus will meet you take you on a tour of the city of Cape Town, visiting it's gardens and an historic church in this city over 300 years old. Then return to your hotel for a little rest and relaxation.

This evening, depart with your group for an included "Welcome to Africa" dinner at Gold Restaurant, complete with dancing, drumming and a 8 course African Dinner!

DAY FOUR | Cape of Good Hope and Penguins

Today your private driver and guide will take you on a tour around the Cape Peninsula's beautifully rugged coastline. Highlights include seeing the African penguin colony at Boulders Beach and visiting the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve, which is home to baboons, several species of antelopes and abundant bird life, as well as seals and dolphins offshore. There are plenty of opportunities to stop for photographs en route, and you can purchase lunch in one of the area's quaint seaside restaurants. After touring is over, your group will head back to the hotel to enjoy the rest of the evening on your own.

DAYS FIVE, SIX AND SEVEN | Godwana Lodge at Sanbona Wildlife Reserve

This morning depart Cape Town for the highlight of your trip, Sanbona Game Reserve! Arrive around noon & check-in to Godwana Luxury Lodge for your four day stay with all included meals. At Sanbona you can immerse yourself in a landscape where wildlife and flora leave you truly captivated and transformed. Sanbona is one of South Africa's largest privately-owned nature reserves, stretching across 153,000 acres of rich protected ecosystems with the biodiversity like Arizona or Southern California. This huge, vast track of land in the Little Karoo is owned by a non-profit company focused on steering conservation to the forefront of the safari experience. Sanbona



offers an authentic and contrasting natural space, striving to create a balance where critically important ecosystems, endangered wildlife and flora can prosper for the benefit of future generations. Spend each day exploring every corner of this immense reserve, endless open plains and sculpted Cape fold mountains to view some of South Africa's most sought-after wildlife. Each morning and evening you will go on a safari game drive where you will get an opportunity to view "The Big Five" - lion, cheetah, elephant, buffalo & rhino. You will *not* see hoards of other folks touring while on this Safari (think the tourist overload at Yellowstone) and you will have a good idea how quiet and serene this place is. In Sanbona, you will truly have your life changed as you immerse yourself in the beauty and wonder of Africa!
