DAY ONE | FLYING TO THE BOTTOM OF THE WORLD

Meet Cindee Forby, your Jeanie's Journeys Adventure Guide inside Terminal 1 at the MSP Airport in front of the Delta counter. There you will meet your fellow travelers and check-in together, one checked suitcase per person allowed. You will then depart in the early evening for your flight to Buenos Aires, with a stop at Atlanta on the way to change planes. You will then continue southward overnight towards Argentina.

DAY TWO | ARRIVING IN SOUTH AMERICA

Around 10:00 AM, arrive in Argentina, where it is nice and warm! You will then head to baggage claim, pick up your luggage and board your waiting bus that will take you to the Port of Buenos Aires. You will then process through customs and board the Grand Princess, where you will check into your room for the next 18 days. Unpack and get ready for the journey of a lifetime! The ship will not be sailing until tomorrow, so enjoy a welcome on-board dinner this evening with your fellow travelers. Your group has several tables reserved for 5:00 PM each evening so you will be able to dine with whom you wish. After some evening entertainment, it's time to head to bed early as you have just spent last night on a plane - enjoy your super comfortable bed!

DAY THREE | BUENOS AIRES

Today take advantage of some of the amazing Shore Excursions that Princess has on offer. Founded in the early 16th century, Buenos Aires was transformed from a colonial port into a cosmopolitan metropolis - the



"Paris of the South" - by the cattle boom of the 1880s. As in the American West, boom was followed by bust. But that did not stop Buenos Aires from becoming the city it is today. With its air of haunted grandeur, Buenos Aires is a place of icy intellect and smoldering passion. It is a city where the elegant Colon Theater, one of the world's great opera houses, stands in counterpoint to the working class barrios that gave birth to the tango. Perhaps the city's enigmas and contradictions are best embodied by its most famous citizen - the showgirl turned First Lady, Evita Peron. The city flaunts its European heritage. One of the pleasures of Buenos Aires is simply absorbing its charm and flavor, from Parisian-style confectioneries - cafés - to the city's popular tango clubs. Enjoy your time in this beautiful city, but don't stay too long as your ship sails away today at 4:00 PM! Enjoy the "Sail Away" party on the top deck with the Princess singers and dancers. Then you are off on your adventure!

DAY SEVEN | PUNTA ARENAS, CHILE

Punta Arenas lies atop rolling hills, looking out over the Strait of Magellan. In the days before the Panama Canal, this was a major port as ships plied the waters of Cape Horn. Punta Arenas remains a prosperous town today, thanks to its rich natural resources. The city is also the gateway to Chilean Patagonia, a maze of fjords, rivers, steppes, and mountains to the north; and to the south lies the great frozen mass of Antarctica. Adventure awaits in any direction at this port located near the end of the earth. Across the Strait of Magellan lies Tierra del Fuego, the lonely, windswept island discovered by Magellan in 1520. This is where you will head tomorrow!

DAY EIGHT | USHUAIA - Tierra Del Fuego

Magellan called it Tierra del Fuego, "the Land of Fire," having seen flames rising from the darkened islands. For over three centuries, the name struck fear in the hearts of mariners. Howling headwinds, mountainous seas, and rocky coastlines spelled a sudden end to many voyages. Today, Ushuaia, a former Argentine penal colony, serves as your gateway to this wilderness where snow-capped mountains plummet to the icy waters of the Beagle Channel.

DAYS NINE - FOURTEEN | ANTARTICA PENNINSULA SCENIC CRUISING

Sail to the Antarctic Peninsula on days nine to fourteen, days ten to thirteen you will cruise Antarctica. The most isolated continent on earth, this rugged landscape is some 1,200 miles long and reaches beyond the Arctic Circle. Its shores are comprised of unusually sculpted icebergs, blue-tinged glaciers, majestic mountain peaks, and a steep ice shelf that continues to shrink at an alarming rate. Though the peninsula is covered in icy tundra, it actually features the mildest climate in Antarctica, the perfect environment for hosting the only flowering plants on the entire continent, Antarctic Hair Grass and Antarctic Pearlwort. icy waters surrounding the peninsula cater to various species of seals, penguins and seabirds, including the Cape Pigeon, the American Sheathbill and the Antarctic Tern. Enjoy your scenic cruise in this remote area of the world - it's a breathtaking wonderland nestled in nature's frosty embrace.

Note: The Antarctic Peninsula is a scenic cruising site. Your Ship will slowly travel past the continent while knowledgeable port lecturers point out significant sites you'll be able to see from on-board. There is no opportunity to depart the ship in this delicate and fragile area of the world.

DAY FIFTEEN | STANLEY, THE FALKLAND ISLANDS

Capital of the Falklands since 1845, tiny Stanley lies on the windswept tip of East Falkland Island. The Falklands long served as a way station for ships, particularly whalers, bound to and from Cape Horn. The islands' rigorous environment is immediately apparent: Stanley Harbor is dotted with the hulks of vessels that succumbed to the fierce winds and waves of the South Atlantic. While their strategic location led to important roles in both World Wars, the islands are best remembered as the cause of the 1982 war between Argentina and the United Kingdom. Today, travelers increasingly journey to the islands to view their rich assortment of bird and marine life. Colorful houses occupy the low rolling moorland bordering Stanley Harbor. Stanley's climate resembles London's - cool and rainy, though summer visitors are often blessed with clear, sunny skies.

DAYS SIXTEEN - SEVENTEEN | RELAX AT SEA PART 2!

On the return voyage continue to immerse yourself in all the sights and sounds of being at sea at the bottom of the world. DAY EIGHTEEN | MONTEVIDEO, URUGUAY

Nestled between Brazil and Argentina, Uruguay is the second smallest country in South America. More than half of the nation's population of three million reside in the capital of Montevideo, located at Uruguay's southernmost point on the Rio de la Plata. Although small in size, Uruguay has proven to be big-hearted; the country is one of the most literate nations in the world. Montevideo is a charming city made up of 19th-century Beaux Arts buildings, parks, and historical monuments. This evening, join your fellow travelers for one last dinner together before heading back to your cabin to pack for suitcases to head home tomorrow.

DAY NINETEEN | BUENOS AIRES

After one last included breakfast, depart your floating vacation home and head with your fellow Minnesotans to a waiting bus that will take you on one more included adventure. You will head to an Argentinian Estancia (Ranch). These authentic cattle ranches are a huge part in the local culture and economy. Enjoy an included gaucho barbecue called Asado, and see a show starring



the Argentine cowboy's famous horsemanship! You then depart for the airport and board your plane which takes off in the late evening. Spend another lovely night on the plane while the hum of the engines rock you to sleep.
