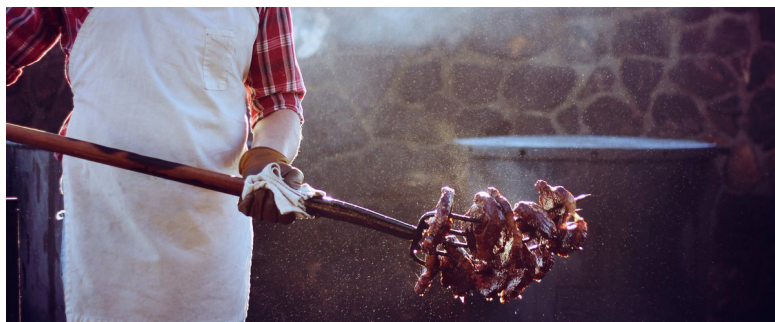

HOTEL: BADLANDS MOTEL, MEDORA

FRIDAY, SEPT. 10 | THEODORE ROOSEVELT NATIONAL PARK & PRESIDENTIAL LIBRARY

After an included breakfast in town, depart for Theodore Roosevelt National Park, named for our 26th President. The park encompasses 110 square miles of breathtaking North Dakota Badlands. Roosevelt first came here to hunt bison in September 1883 and fell in love with the region. We'll explore prairies, rivers and Badlands that are home to bison, wild horses, bighorn sheep, elk and other wildlife. After touring the park, head to the brand-new Theodore Roosevelt Presidential Library. Enjoy lunch and plenty of time to explore the museum at your leisure. This evening is yours to enjoy downtown Medora.

SATURDAY, SEPT. 11 | BREAKFAST WITH TEDDY

This morning, get up early for a chance to see the hot air balloons rise into the sky at dawn at the Medora Balloon Rally- a beautiful scene with the badlands as a backdrop! Then head to a buffet breakfast with none other than TR—Teddy Roosevelt! He'll regale you with stories of his life in Medora. After breakfast, enjoy time to shop downtown before heading east. Stop in Dickinson, ND, for lunch on your own before continuing to Bismarck for the night. This evening, enjoy a farewell dinner overlooking the Missouri River.

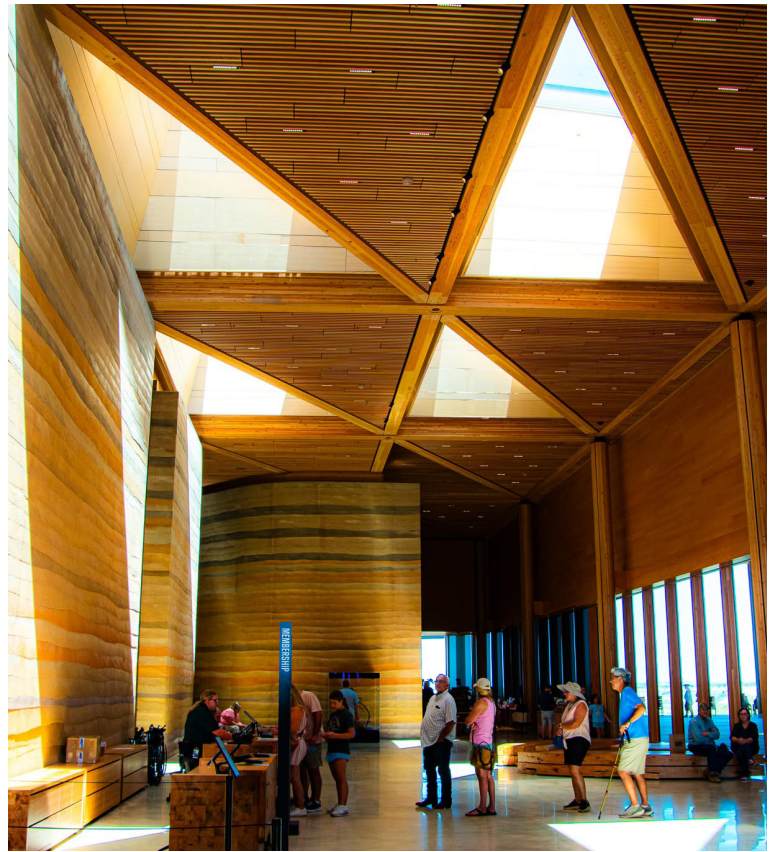
