Friday, January 16 | Touring Cape Town

This morning after an included breakfast, a local guide will meet you at your hotel and take you to Table Mountain. Then you will embark on the Cable Car at the lower cable car station. The cable car will rotate to give you a full 360 degree view of the City of Cape Town for 3 minutes. When you arrive at the Upper Cable car station, you will have some free time to walk around on top of the mountain. You can also have a coffee and a snack as a restaurant is located there. Your bus will meet you and take you to touring to Signal Hill, Camps Bay Beach Maiden's Cove in Clifton, Bantry Bay and Sea Point Promenade until you reach Bo-kaap, a Cape Georgian community formerly known as the Cape Malay Quarter. Bo-kaap's endemic architectural structures, cobbled stoned streets and brightly colored walls makes for a great photo session but it is also her 300 years old history that impresses. You will then drive through the city to the Diamond Museum. South Africa is very Rich in Diamonds and Gold After this last stop,



it's time to head back to your hotel for an included "Welcome to Africa" dinner in the hotel restaurant, overlooking the ocean.

Saturday, January 17 | Cape of Good Hope and Penguins

Today your private driver and guide will take you on a tour around the Cape Peninsula's beautifully rugged coastline. Highlights include seeing the African penguin colony at Boulders Beach, strolling around the Kirstenbosch National Botanical Garden and visiting the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve, which is home to baboons, several species of antelopes and abundant bird life, as well as seals and dolphins offshore. There are plenty of opportunities to stop for photographs en route, and you can purchase lunch in one of the area's quaint seaside towns. After touring is over, your group will head back to the hotel to enjoy the rest of the evening on your own.

Sunday, January 18 | Driving The Garden Route

This morning depart your hotel in Cape Town for your journey to Oudtshoorn. The journey takes you through a breathtaking mountain pass, the arid Karoo area and along Route 62, said to be the most scenic route in South Africa, cutting through an expanse of vineyards, huge mountains and deep-cut valleys. You will then arrive at Chandelier Game Lodge where you will check in to your tented cabin for the evening. After enjoying some time to walk around the farm or enjoy some relaxation, it's time for dinner. A perfect ending



to an unforgettable day is the popular Sundowner Bush Dinner. You are transported to a lapa (shelter) high up in the mountains on open land rovers. At the lapa enjoy the beauty that surrounds you while watching the unique sunset over the Swartberg mountains. While the magnificent sunset gives way to the silence of the night, the guides do a traditional South African braai (barbeque), including kudu, ostrich and springbuck. The traditional African three course dinner includes a variety of traditional South African foods. After dinner, enjoy guided star gazing from the lapa, where the stars of the Southern Hemisphere are so bright that you can almost touch them. The night is concluded with a night game drive with spot lights to watch the behavior of the creatures of the night. After the Sundowner Bush Dinner, a peaceful sleep and sweet dreams, in luxurious tented chalets, are guaranteed
