**DAY 1 | JAMESTOWN, NORTH DAKOTA**

Join new friends & old as you depart the Minneapolis area by luxury motor coach for North Dakota & Medora! A lot of fun jokes will be told & games played along the way. There will be a fast food stop along the way for lunch on your own. Your group will then arrive in Jamestown, North Dakota for a stop at the Historic Pioneer Village and to see the worlds largest buffalo statue! You will then check into your local Jamestown hotel for the evening with an included dinner.

**DAY 2 | HISTORIC ROUGH RIDER HOTEL**

You will then arrive at your hour historic hotel right in the center of Medora, North Dakota where you will stay for the next two nights. **DAY 3 | MAGICAL MEDORA!**

After an included breakfast in town, depart to visit Theodore Roosevelt National Park, named for the 26th President of the United States. The park covers 110 square miles of breathtaking vistas in the beautiful North Dakota Badlands. Roosevelt first came here to hunt bison in September of 1883, and fell in love with the region. We'll see prairies, rivers and badlands that are home to bison, wild horses, bighorn sheep, elk and many other wildlife. Your group will also enjoy a drive through the "Petified Forest". Then it's back to your hotel in Medora where lunch will be on your own along with some free time to shop, explore or just relax in your room. Then, head across the street to see



"Teddy Roosevelt's Salute To Medora", a spectacular one man show. You'll learn about Theodore Roosevelt as a president, husband, father, soldier, hunter and Badlands rancher. The motorcoach will be waiting outside after the show to whisk you to the Pitchfork Fondue dinner, a savory slab o' top choice steak fondued on a pitchfork, western style! Then add baked potatoes, baked beans, coleslaw, fresh fruits and vegetables, garlic toast, cinnamon sugar doughnuts, brownies, lemonade, coffee, and water to complete the Fondue experience! Then, it's time for the highlight of your tour ~ The Medora Musical! Enjoy western cowboy style singing & dancing in an outdoor amphitheater. The backdrop is the beautiful badlands as you tap your feet to the music & watch the stars come out. You will then return to your hotel for the rest of the evening at about 9:00PM.
